

### 1.5 Protected Professional Titles and Endorsements

The recognized, and in-use, protected titles for paramedic professionals are:

- Critical Care Paramedic (CCP)
- Advanced Care Paramedic (ACP)
- Primary Care Paramedic (PCP)
- Emergency Medical Responder (EMR)

Additionally, only Critical Care Paramedics, Advanced Care Paramedics and Primary Care Paramedics who are regulated members of the College may also use the general title/term paramedic

The College is currently authorized to recognize the following register categories as per the Paramedics Profession Regulation (PPR):

- Advanced Care Paramedic (ACP)
- Primary Care Paramedic (PCP)
- Emergency Medical Responder (EMR)

Therefore, the use of the title of Critical Care Paramedic (CCP) is authorized to a regulated Advanced Care Paramedic who has:

1. Completed a College-approved training program; and
2. Received and maintains authorization from the College for explicit use of the title

Endorsements are used to indicate additional training or education a regulated member has successfully completed which enables them to provide additional restricted activities/healthcare interventions.

A regulated member must:

1. Use only the protected title for the which they are authorized to use by the College.
2. Portray and communicate their professional title truthfully to patients, employers, other healthcare providers and stakeholders.
3. Use only the endorsements granted by the College and listed on the College's register.
